THE CHALLENGE

Cathedral Court Co-operative is one of two co-ops in the St. Lawrence Neighborhood. The challenges of this project include the following: extremely high electricity bills due to electrical heaters, limited space for the indoor units, heating was not available in very low temperatures, and there was no cooling.

THE SOLUTION

The units were installed due to their low initial cost, total heating and cooling solution, ability to have auxiliary heating, and smaller indoor units. Outdoor units installed include: SUZ-KA15KA and SUZ-KA18KA. Indoor units installed include: SEZ-KD15KA/SEZ-KD18KA. Controls were PAR-32MAA and PAC-YU25HY and other products include duct heaters.
